USCIS Response to Coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19)



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Alert: On Sept. 29, 2020, the U.S. District Court for the Northern District of California in Immigration Legal Resource Center et al., v. Wolf, et al., 20-cv-05883-JWS, preliminarily enjoined DHS from implementing or enforcing any part of the USCIS Fee Schedule and Changes to Certain Other Immigration Benefit Request Requirements rule.

While the rule is preliminarily enjoined, we will continue to:

- Accept USCIS forms with the current editions and current fees; and
- Use the regulations and guidance currently in place to adjudicate applications and petitions. This includes accepting and adjudicating fee waiver requests as provided under Adjudicator's Field Manual (AFM) Chapters <u>10.9 (PDF, 2.87 MB)</u> and <u>10.10 (PDF, 2.87 MB)</u>.

Alert: USCIS is implementing the U.S. District Court for the District of Maryland's Sept. 11
preliminary injunction in Casa de Maryland Inc. et. al. v. Chad Wolf et. al.

This preliminary injunction provides limited injunctive relief to members of two organizations, CASA de Maryland (CASA) and the Asylum Seeker Advocacy Project (ASAP), in the application of the <u>Removal of 30-day Processing Provision for Asylum Applicant-Related Form I-765</u> <u>Employment Authorization Applications Rule</u> and the <u>Asylum Application, Interview, and</u> <u>Employment Authorization for Applicants Rule</u> to Form I-589s and Form I-765s filed by asylum applicants who are also members of CASA or ASAP.

Alert: Applicants for Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands (CNMI) Long-Term Resident Status: You must submit Form I-955 with your Form I-765. You may only apply for CNMI long-term resident status until Aug. 17, 2020.

Certain aliens who are in the United States may file Form I-765, Application for Employment Authorization, to request employment authorization and an <u>Employment Authorization Document</u> (EAD). Other

aliens whose immigration status authorizes them to work in the United States without restrictions may also use Form I-765 to apply to U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services (USCIS) for an EAD that shows such authorization.
